### DATES AND HOURS

#### What are the Show dates and hours?

The 2022 Philadelphia Flower Show will run from June 11 – 19, 2022  
The hours are:

#### Saturday, June 11 – Saturday, June 18: 10 am – 8 pm

- No guest entry after 7:30pm
- 9am entry for PHS members

#### Sunday, June 19: 10 am – 6 pm

- No guest entry at 5:30pm
- 9am entry for PHS members

Re-entry on your existing ticket is not permitted at this year's Show.

### TO VOLUNTEER

#### How do you view and sign up for Flower Show shifts?

#### Do volunteers get free parking?

Yes. Volunteers will get free parking at the Navy Yard in the 'S' lot on the day they volunteer. From the 'S' lot in the Navy Yard, a free shuttle will be provided to the Show. Here is the address for that parking lot: 7012-7096 League Island Blvd, Philadelphia, PA 19112.

#### Can you volunteer as a group?

#### What age do I have to be to volunteer?

We are happy to welcome volunteers as young as 14 to the Flower Show! Volunteers aged 14-15 need to be accompanied by a parent. Volunteers aged 16 and 17 will need to have a parent's acknowledgement of the PHS Covid-19 and General Waiver, which can be acknowledged while signing up for any in-person shift at <http://flowershow.phs.volunteerhub.com>.

#### Do volunteers have to pay for a ticket on the day they volunteer?

No. Each volunteer will receive an e-ticket for the day they volunteer. Each volunteer will also receive an extra ticket for any day to come back and enjoy the Show or they can choose to give it to someone else.

#### Will volunteers have to be vaccinated before volunteering?

PHS volunteers are required to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19: two doses of an approved two dose vaccine or one dose of an approved one dose vaccine. If you already have a VolunteerHub account, the next time you sign up for an opportunity, it will ask you to upload proof of vaccination. If you are

creating an account, it will ask you to upload proof of vaccination before your account is fully created. **Is there required training for Flower Show volunteers?**

Yes. There is a required training for volunteers for the 2022 Flower Show. It will be a pre-recorded virtual training that will be sent via email in May.

**Can I leave my belongings somewhere when I volunteer?**

It is not encouraged, and the area that the belongings will be in will not be watched. We recommend small bags that you can keep on you during your shift.

**How long are typical volunteer shifts?**

They are around 3 hours.
